Entry requirements

Set by individual employers and the regulator, but typically includes:

- 120 UCAS points, or
- GCSEs at grade 4/5 or above, including English language and mathematics, or
- A Higher Education Certificate in Health and Social Care, or
- Equivalent with care experience, and
- Digital literacy

and if you are a non-native user of English, you must provide evidence of:

- Instruction and assessment predominantly in English throughout education, or
- A recent IELTS or equivalent score of 7.0 overall, with a minimum of 7.0 for each component

You must be employed in a role relevant to this programme to be eligible to apply.

Is this for you?

There will also be opportunities for you to take a lead in healthcare developments through your commitment and outstanding communication skills.

Typical job roles for individuals studying this programme include Staff Nurse, Sister/Charge Nurse and Clinical Educator.
